GENERAL PURPOSE

Performs a variety of **entry level clerical and administrative support** duties to County Assessor and staff .document; assists with customer service.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Works under the direct supervision of the County Assessor.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Performs various clerical and secretarial duties; may assist appraisers in field-related work, and other Assessor Office staff on an as-needed basis; operates scanning equipment to scan and create permanent records.

Updates and maintains various files of documents generated through the on-going operations of the office of County Assessor.

Assists in front counter duties as needed.

Must be able to navigate computer programs and performs various data entry; assists with maintaining filing systems, and filing.

Performs general clerical duties and related duties as required.

Performs related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. Education and Experience:
 - A. Graduation from high school;
 - AND
 - B. One (1) year of experience performing above or related duties.
 - OR
 - C. An equivalent combination of education and experience.

2. Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

Some knowledge of standard office procedures and policies; good English usage, grammar, and spelling; basic mathematics involving the use of addition, subtraction, multiplication and percentages; operation of standard office equipment; filing systems, alphabetical and numerical; computer operation; interrelationships of various functions within department of county assessor; good people skills to work with the public; telephone etiquette; basic interpersonal communication skills; various computer applications such as MS Word, Excel, etc.

Ability to follow written or oral instructions; work in a standard office setting requiring extensive sitting or standing; perform accurate mathematical computations; write legibly; communicate effectively, verbally and in writing; develop effective working relationships with supervisors, fellow employees, and the public.

3. Special Qualifications:

Must take an interest in work assignments and produce accurate results.

4. Work Environment:

Incumbents of the position perform in a typical office setting with appropriate climate controls. Tasks require variety of physical activities, not generally involving muscular strain, and does involve walking, standing, stooping, lifting, sitting, reaching, talking, hearing and seeing. Rapid work speed required to perform keyboard operations. Common eye, hand, finger, leg and foot dexterity exist. Mental application utilizes memory for details, verbal instructions, emotional stability and discriminating thinking.
